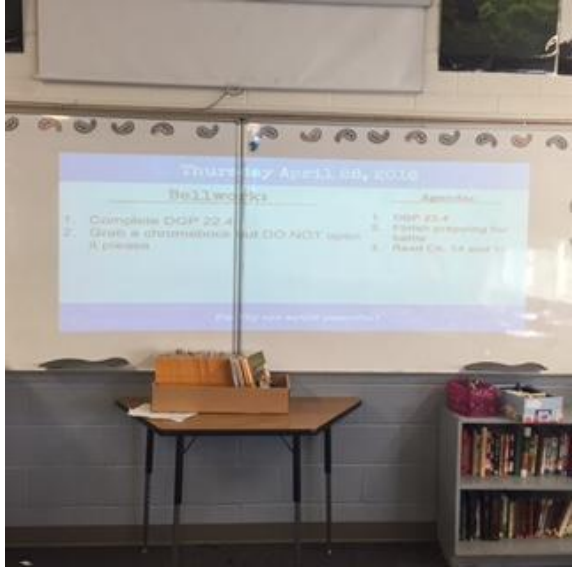


Artifact:

Domain Three, Communicating With Students

For students, one of the most helpful things is giving them all the resources needed to be successful. This artifact demonstrates one form of communication I have with them so they may be successful. The first photo is a picture of my board, which shows what's happening that week. On Mondays they write down the weekly plan in their agendas, which helps them stay organized and allows them to anticipate what will be happening that week. The second photo is put up at the beginning of each period. It plays two roles. The first is to inform them of their bell work, which keeps them on task once the bell rings. Secondly, the purpose is to inform them the details of what's happening that day, along with the essential question being focused on. Students who are able to anticipate what's ahead in a classroom, are able to better understand the content and purpose of it each day. This piece demonstrates a strong form of communication I have with my students.
